Review and report all chest X-Ray images as per survey protocol and SOP in a time bound manner. Identify other medical conditions as well as the triage by coordinating with the local health facilities as well as referral to higher centers as and when necessary. Establishing coordination and support from local health facilities Visit all the survey sites for staff training and monitoring of survey activities.
